## Dimension Specifications for standard "Basic Page" for LHPC Website

This document provides the dimensions and layout rules for the standard webpage on the www.lhphotoclub.com website.

The standard page is the blank page generated by the WIX Editor whenever the webmaster creates a "New Page" using the PAGES panel. The PAGES panel is launched by selecting the "Pages HOME" menu option in the Editor's Main Menu. The specification for the Basic Page, regarding dimensions, should never be deviated from that which is presented in this document.

This document also contains specifications for positioning Container Boxes on the basic page. Container Boxes are the primary tool used to support the placement and layout of content (i.e., photos \& text) on the page. As such, they form the fundamental building blocks for the website. As presented here they represent the typical dimensions to be used when adding content to the NEWS page. Deviations from the standard will be at the discretion of the "Content Originator" (i.e., the person responsible for adding content and managing the layout) with the final approval of the Webmaster.

This specification is not mean't to stifle creativity on the part of Content Originators, but provide guidance relative to the requirements necessary to maintain the structural integrity of the website.

This document does not deal with the specifications for Color or Type styles. Separate Specifications Documents will be issued to cover those and other topics.
