**This is our Photography Club’s Annual Spring
“Photo Safari at Ferrari” a.k.a. “Larry’s Pond”**

Note: Keep CDC COVID-19 precautions in mind. As this walk is outdoors and is a highly popular walking trail, not everyone will be wearing masks and distancing may be difficult. Each person is solely responsible for their own COVID related behavior and risks.

Friday, April 2, 2021

Larry and Truman are at the “Pond” nearly every morning as they photograph many of the animals. We’ve seen many of these photographs of birds, raptors, coyotes, mink and other creatures in many of our club meetings; now they are going to share their expertise & locations as we walk with them.

When: **Friday, April 2, 2021.**

Times: **1. Meet at 7:30 am for early birds/eager beavers tour**
2. Meet at 8:00 am for sleepy heads tour

Where: Meet up at Angler’s Cove on Ingram. If parking is full (likely) park in the neighborhoods. Or you can park on Violet Lane at the north east end of the trail and join the group out on the trail.

If you arrive late, just follow the trail until you reach the group.

Equipment: Bring what you have for low lighting, wildlife, flowers, landscapes and people. Larry & Truman love to use 100-400 telephoto lens. A lens hood is helpful to avoid the early morning sun “flares” on your lens. Bring any camera you have, just get out and enjoy.

Sex: Most of the wildlife will be very active, either having, or trying to have, sex. Many babies are on the way but it may be a few weeks before making their grand entrances.

Walking: This is a walking safari on the trails. Restroom available at the Fishing Pond. The trail is just over one mile including a spur trail to Salt Pond – each way. You can turn back anytime you need to go on to other activities.

Parking: Either Angler’s Cove on Ingram, in the nearby neighborhood or at the other end of the trail, on Violet between 532 Violet and 610 Violet Lane near the trail entrance.

Driving directions to the Violet trail entrance: Travel north from the OC Lodge area on Sun City Blvd, at about ½ mile turn left onto Tiger Lilly Lane, then immediate left onto Violet Lane.

This parking area has much more room for many cars and it’s closer to Salt Pond. But you will miss starting with everyone else at Angler’s Cove.

Weather: It will be cool in the morning. If raining the event will be rescheduled.

No Sign up: No sign up needed, just show up for a “party at the pond”.
