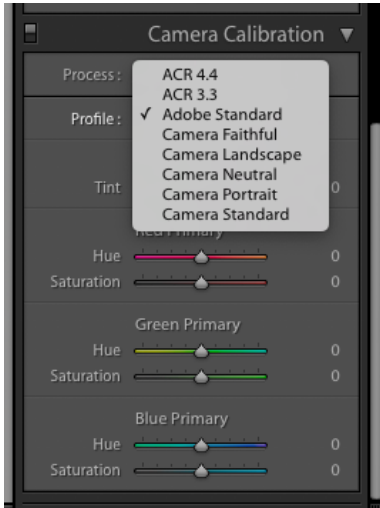

Lightroom Quick Tips

1. Camera Calibration: Profiles. Select to suit your preference.



2. Set White Balance: Basic Panel – WB

- a. Select Preset
- b. Use Eyedropper
- c. Use Temperature and Tint sliders

3. White & Black Clipping

- a. Drag White Slider / Drag Black Slider
- b. Automatic Method:**
 - i. Shift + Double Click over White Point Slider
 - ii. Shift + Double Click over Black Point Slider

4. Open up Dark Shadow Areas: Shadows Slider (Be Careful-Too Far Too Flat)

5. Adjust Exposure: (Controls the Midtones - Upper Darks & Lower Highlights)

6. For sky or very light areas, adjust Highlights slider to -100

7. Readjust Exposure if neccessary

8. Add Contrast

9. Add Clarity

10. If Necessary Add Tone Curves (Tone Curve Panel) to fine tune tones
