Trails Enhancement Project (TEP)

Introduction

Our Community in Lincoln Hills is blessed with nearly 488 acres of Open Space and 26 miles of trails that transect our neighborhoods and wildlife areas. These trails meander through our community and enrich our lives by supporting the varied and interesting wildlife that inhabits these areas. These Open Space areas and Trails are managed by both the U.S. Army Corp of Engineers and the Wildlife Heritage Foundation.

In order to enhance the outdoor experience of our Sun City Lincoln Hills residents, the Association created the Trails Enhancement Project (TEP) and tasked a Trails Enhancement Team to research and develop ideas for the improvement of the Trail maps, Trail signage, Distance markers and a new Trail Guide Book.

Valued components of this compiled information will be displayed as photographic images of the local flora and fauna in our area.

In order to accomplish this project, we are asking you, our resident photographers, to submit images to be incorporated in our trail information.

Subject Matter

Attached is a list of the Animals, Birds, Insects, Flowers and Scenics that we are considering. The Trails Enhancement Team will review all images and select those photographs that depict the subject in a natural environment. Each subject needs to be accurate to our location in Lincoln Hills. The subject should also be a clear representation of the bird, plant or animal and it should be an esthetically pleasing presentation and in correct proportion to other subject depictions.

Photo Credit

Please do not submit an image that displays your name.

As we celebrate our environment and community, we also celebrate the artistry of our contributors. Photo credit will be given in the following three (3) forms:

1. In an unobtrusive manner on the Trail Sign, each photo will be credited to the photographer.
2. On the website for the Trails Enhancement, images will be displayed with credit to the photographer.
3. Upon the completion of the installment of the signs on the trail, an article in the compass will announce the installation and display the images with credit to the photographer.

We appreciate and value your contribution.

Photo Format

The final use of the images, may be printed as 15 inches by 15 inches or 15 inches by 7 inches or 7 inches by 7 inches. We understand that you may crop and enhance your images, so to maintain your artistry, images are needed in the following two forms:

1. For selection purposes, please provide on a flash drive your cropped and enhanced images as JPGs at least 200 ppi with the shortest side length of 1000 pixels.
2. After the images are selected, we ask you submit your uncropped and enhanced image as a JPG at 300 ppi with the shortest side length of 4500 pixels.
3. Naming suggestion – Your initials, subject name, image number i.e. cwscaliforniaquail1 for first image and cwscaliforniaquail2 for the second image.

We will return all of your flash drives.

The deadline for submissions is June 26, 2018
